Monday- Hawaiian Dance

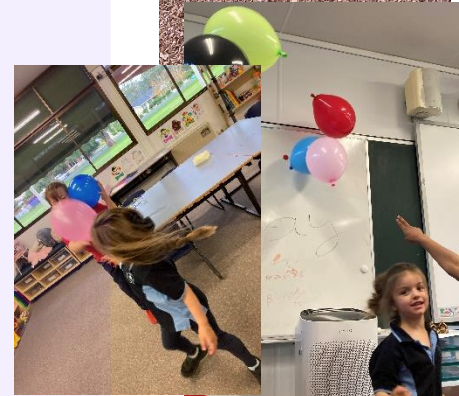
Tuesday- Animal Dance
