# Catholic Identity

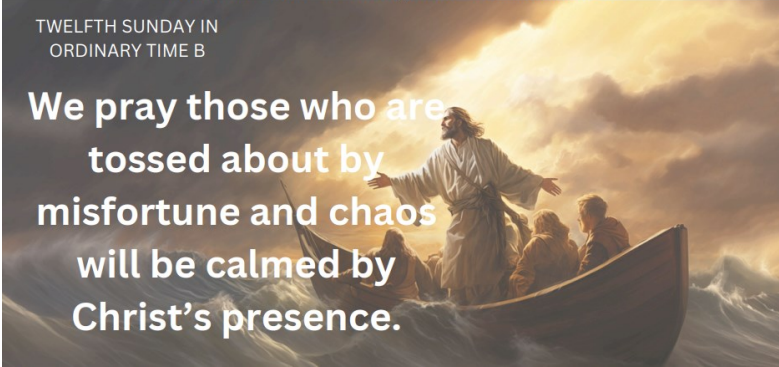


This week's passage includes one of the great nature miracles of Jesus - the calming of the storm.

Please return this form to OSHClub by the **21/6/2024**, cupcakes will be made the following week and given out to the person on the order form. Cupcakes are \$1 each.

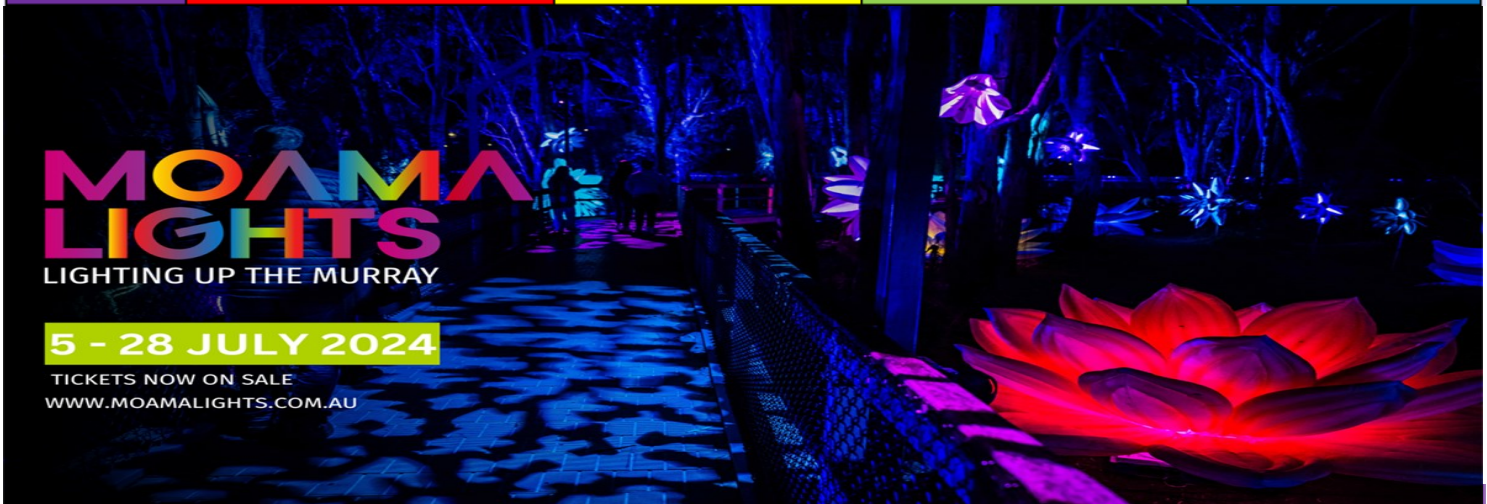
