Thirteen students from Our Lady of the Sacred Heart in East Bentleigh visited OLSH Elmore on Friday, November 8, leading the school community in prayer before participating in the annual Mission Day fundraiser for the OLSH sisters in Sudan. The visiting students organized stalls, including face painting and jewellery-making. This year's event held special significance as it honoured 150 years of the Daughters of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart and acknowledged the 90 years of their dedicated service in Elmore. Sister Shirley, who lived for ten years in the Elmore convent serving the Elmore community, joined us for the day. A commemorative plaque was placed next to 150 ceremonial roses to mark the occasion. (two Hayes' children sit next to Sister Shirley/a very significant photo as the Hayes family have a very long connection to OLSH Elmore.)
